As always we will provide the grills and the coal (there will be 5 grills, **one of which will be for vegetarians**, therefore, please watch out where you put your steaks and sausages our vegetarian friends will appreciate it.)

When: Saturday, Jun 19, 2010, starting at 4 pm

Where: Düsseldorf Niederkassel, Next to the Theodor-Heuss-Bruecke, near the Rhine but still on the grass (not the gravel) s. attached map

What to bring: Please bring what you want to eat and drink, something to sit on, some nice friends, maybe a jacket, in case it cools down in the evening, otherwise sun protection

What, if it rains: The BBQ will be cancelled and we'll give it another try at a later time.

What if you are not sure, if the weather is ok: call 0162-3089609 and ask.

How to get there:

By car: You can look out for a parking spot at Kaiser-Friedrich-Ring or somewhere around Niederkassel

By bicycle - definitely the easiest way ;-). Cycle along the Rhine on the Oberkasseler side from Oberkasseler Brücke until you get to Theodor-Heuss-Brücke and then go down from the dike right after you've gone underneath the bridge.

By public transportation:

a) Take U 74, 75, 76, 77 to Belsenplatz and catch a bus # 828, 834, 836 to Niederkasseler Kirchweg or bus # 834 to Niederkassel and walk from there (about 10 minutes)

b) take one of the above undergrounds and get off at Barbarossaplatz and catch bus # 833 to "An der Apfelweide" and walk from there (about 5 minutes)

c) Take U 74, 76, 77 to Heerdter Sandberg and walk along Niederkasseler Kirchweg (about 15 minutes)
